

ST. PETERSBURG FREE CLINIC

Julie Bostick from the St. Petersburg Free Clinic gave information about the efforts of the Free Clinic and its partner agencies to address the problem of hunger in Pinellas County. (Helping the hungry is only one of 8 programs of the Free Clinic.)

There are now 7,000 chronically hungry children in Pinellas County. 1,500 of those children receive “pack a sack” food for the weekend. The Free Clinic is now partnering with Bob Dillinger to feed the other children on weekends.

The Free Clinic, with its 63 partner agencies, feed 40,000 hungry people per year in Pinellas County.

And they feed 100 people, 6 nights per week at the Community Kitchen at Beacon House.
